Playing Fields/Wildlife Areas inc: • To note Play Area Monthly Inspection for September The Play inspection report was noted. Clerk to report the areas (eg Bignall End Road and Alsager Road) which contain the worse dog fouling to David Beardmore for monitoring. Clerk had instructed Aardwolf to deal with the ongoing mole issue at Albert Street. Noted that the posts at Miles Green Play area had been superglued, so Mr Hough had been asked to resolve the issue. Mr Moody reported that there was human waste found at Leddys Field, Clerk including toilet roll. Clerk to report this to Street Scene to see if there can be Clerk anything done with regards to remote CCTV. Clerk had instructed Mr Hough to repair the fence at Rileys Field and chain up the bin. Cllr Beech attended at this point in the meeting. Approval of any action required or taken under Delegated Authority: 1. Acco drain at Alsager Road Play area installed – this was approved. 2. Further damage to the Bignall End Rd grass mats - noted that there was no further damage, the resident who reported the issue had mistaken it. To identify the two play areas for painting as per the Annual maintenance **RESOLVED** that Mr Hough be instructed to paint the 2 play areas in most need. Clerk 12. To consider approving the renewal for the insurance (PL, Fidelity and EL) at a cost of £2.819.40 It was **RESOLVED** to sign up for the Long Term Agreement for 3 years (ending in October 2018) and benefit from a discount (total payable £2,678.43). 13. Dog control at Bateswood – Mr T Sproston Mr Sproston reported that the original signs (dogs on leads) that were installed when the control order came into force were no longer present. As a result there is often cases of people letting dogs chase wildlife and sending their dogs into the water. Some have seen ducks shot or taken by the dogs. Cllr Beech to AB request Mr Middlehurst to install new signs to ask people to avoid it in the (Clerk) interests of wildlife and to locate them in the water this time. 14.
