2.	To consider approving and signing minutes of the Parish Council meeting			
	on 20 <sup>th</sup> July 2017 – <b>RESOLVED</b> that this be approved and signed.			
3.	Declaration of interest in any item-none were declared.			
4.	Public Participation: No issues raised.			
5.	To receive a presentation from Mr Gez Willard, WW Planning regarding			
	a potential plan for a Co-op store in Bignall End and associated works.			
	The Chairman welcomed Mr Willard from WW Planning to the meeting and explained to the public that it was an unusual situation for an applicant to come			
	to a Parish Council meeting with a proposal prior to the formal request for			
	consultation from Newcastle Borough Council. The Chairman stated			
	questions were welcome at the end of the presentation and were to be taken			
	through the Chair. The main points are summarised as follows:			
	Mr Willard apologised that his colleague from the Coop was not present as Mr			
	Willard could only answer questions from a Planning perspective and not from			
	a commercial venture position.			
	The development included car parking space for 18 vehicles with cycle			
	storage. There was sufficient space at the rear of the proposed development			
	for HGV deliveries and turning space. The site was 418 sq. m; the majority of			
	which was storage space. The stock would be everything you would expect to			
	see in a local Cooperative store.			
	The original plan was for 12 dwellings and that had been reduced to 6. As			
	there was no further space on the site to accommodate 12 dwellings. The 6			
	that had been started would be finished. If the Coop did not take up the retail			
	option it would be opened up to other retailers.			
	Mr Willard was unable to state what would happen to the other Coop store			
	one mile away. However, he reiterated that the current climate with the Coop			
	was to expand and not rationalise their local stores within communities. Mr			
	Willard stated he would ask the question of the Coop and feed back to the			
	Parish Council. He would also ask whether the community would have any			
	influence on the proposed opening hours as there were concerns about ASB			
	and how the Coop would address those potential issues with long opening			
	hours.			
	The Planning application was not yet at the stage where the Parish Council			
	had been asked to formally comment-this was anticipated in early September.			
	It was stressed that any objections to the application must be on material			
	planning grounds. Usually decisions would be made by officers under			
	delegated authority. However, the public have been asking Cllrs Beech and			
	Frankish to "call in" any potential decision so the application could be heard			
	by the full Planning Committee at Newcastle Borough Council.			
	Mr Willard was thanked for his attendance and he left the meeting.
