**RESOLVED** to NOT SUPPORT this development as it is considered to be inappropriate development within the Green Belt with no special circumstances to warrant building another house and outweigh the harm to the openness of the Green Belt – conflicting with the Green Belt Policy. Additionally the site had recently been refused permission albeit for a slightly larger property, it was however still considered inappropriate to construct any new dwelling in the Green Belt with no special circumstances present. The dwelling permitted under 14/00322/FUL has not yet been built therefore this application will not be infill development. The Planning Department are asked to remain consistent with their earlier decisions. The traffic issues are worsening on that road, with double parking present and on pavements.
